Our new vicar Revd Mark Ruoff will be leading this evening together.

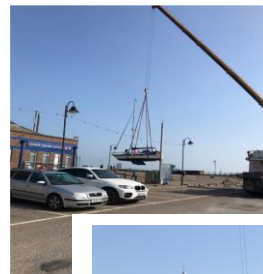
Let's see what God has in store for us all!!!
